


About KEPRO



KEPRO brings together key players in the **packaging for the nonhazardous** products value chain to address post-consumer waste in Kenya. This includes:


- Plastics: flexible plastics, PET plastics, rigid/hard plastics





Our Impact and Presence

- > Presence in **31 counties** in Kenya and growing
- ➤ Worked with over **11 recyclers** & recovered **9,000 + metric tons** of of post-consumer flexible plastic to date
- ➤ Through revenues, paid a total of **KES 85.59 Million + VAT** to recyclers in the form of subsidies
- ➤ Spent over **KES 4 Million** supporting sustainable waste management practices through CBOs, Schools, Churches etc.
- ➤ Rolled out consumer awareness campaigns on sustainable waste management practices directly impacting **1,000+** individuals

What is the incremental cost with EPR?

- > @ 10 Ksh/kg additional on packaging cost
- Approximately 200 bags/kg
- > EPR Fee = 0.05 ksh/bag

60.05 Ksh/loaf
