

Our attention has been drawn to information circulating on social media networks claiming that NEMA officials are colluding with police officers to flag down private and public vehicles in search of plastic bags. It's also claimed that the same officers are arresting members of the public and soliciting bribes to be set free.

Members of the public are hereby informed that NEMA has not sanctioned any actions to stop and inspect private or public vehicles for plastic bags. The NEMA Director General and Inspector General of Police are in constant communication and coordinating what the Authority is doing. The police is aiding the NEMA officials to access business premises for inspections.

NEMA officers are also obliged to identify themselves in the course of their work.
