The National Environment Management Authority (NEMA) hereby announces a "Call for Proposals" on Adaptation projects and programmes for funding by the Adaptation Fund. The proposals should be within the thematic areas recognized under UNFCCC namely,

- i) Water Management
- ii) Agriculture and Food Security
- iii) Coastal Management
- iv) Disaster Risk Reduction
- v) Urban & Rural Development



What is Climate Change Adaptation?

Climate change adaptation is any action taken to minimize the adverse effects or to take advantage of any beneficial effects of climate change. Adaptation is any adjustment in natural or human systems that enhance the resilience of a country against the adverse effects of climate change. Examples of Adaptation activities are water harvesting, promotion of drought tolerant crops, early warning systems among many others.



Eligible applicants for funding include, all Government Ministries and Agencies, NGOs, Civil Society Organizations and Private Sector.

NEMA is urging interested project proponents to develop integrated climate change adaptation projects, preferably

demonstrating participation by many institutions with diverse competencies. These project proposals should be guided by national strategies and policies in



order to ensure consistency with the national priorities. In addition, the development of projects and programmes is expected to give special attention to the needs of most vulnerable communities.

In development of these proposals, it is imperative that reference is made to the following Government Documents;
